Annual child sponsorship educational program at Udayapur Nepal program was organized by HEARD Nepal collaboration with Shree Janata secondary school Hadiya-09 Udayapur Nepal.
- HEARD Nepal signed general agreement for 2 years between Agnisair krishnasavran rural municipality, Saptari of Mahdesh province and Budhiganga rural municipality at Morang district of koshi province for the Nutrition and maternal new born health & child health care strengthening projects.
- Conducted Survey at Agnisair Krishna savaran RM, Saptari, Budhiganga RM, Morang and Barju RM, Sunsari for the survey of Wash health and nutrition where all the palika's representatives were present. Conducted Wash health and nutrition survey ,specially focusing on 0 to 59 month's children of all wards based on the sample size. 1140 HHs and 15 KII with palika epresentative like ward chair, health coordinator, deputy mayor, CAO and PHN and 5 FGD. Survey was done in paper based by using mixed methodology.

One day Free Health Camp and Blood Donation Program was held at Sitapaila-4, Nagarjun Municipality, and Kathmandu in Sitapaila secondary School on 17th June, 2023, with the collaboration of Nagarjun Municipality, Sitapaila Secondary School, HEARD Nepal and Riyukai Nepal along with Technical Partners Red-Cross Society Nepal and Suvekchya International Hospital, Sitapaila-4. The intent of the program was to conduct free health camp and blood donation program. The attendees of the program were Mayor of Nagarjun Municipality Mr. Mohan Bahadur Basnet, Head of Ward no. 4 Mr. Laxmi Ram Sharma, Former minister of Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Supplies Mr. Ramesh Rijal, representatives and volunteers of consortium partners.
