### Detailed activity report

#### Objectives:

##### General Objective:

- To aware people through conducting a rally against Gender Based Violence aligning with the 16 Days of GBV activism.

#### Program Planned Activity and its Achievement

##### *Component I: GBV Rally*

16 Days of Activism against Gender Based Violence is a worldwide movement which starts from November 25 to December 10 every year. This year's slogan was "UNITE! **Activism** to end **violence against** women and girls". The major goal of this activism is to eliminate violence against women and girls.

In support of this activism, HEARD Nepal conducted a rally for GBV activism. The rally was conducted in collaboration with Health Office, Saptari and different Medical colleges of Saptari such as Unique college, Saptarishi college and chinnamasta college. Youths from various backgrounds such as nursing, public health, and pharmacy were approached. Around 300 were participated in the rally. The major motive of the rally was to aware the community people on gender based violence. The rally started from Health Office, Saptari and ended at Tribhuvan Chwok Rajbiraj. Slogans were delivered in the mass through mike and speaker. HEARD Nepal gained experience working as a team and independently planning an event with the students.

### ***Component II: GBV Rally Speech***

After the completion of the rally wonderful speech was delivered by some of the students from the respective college. The delivery of speech was also given by the police officer and he shared his experience on his colleague having faced GBV for months. The sad reality of our society was reflected and what can be done by our side being the new generation was deliberated. Our public health consultant Ms. Rojina Lama and founding president Mr. Rakesh Kumar Yadav also shared their views on GBV existing in our community.
