Background

HEARD Nepal as an organization striving to work on the benefit of the marginalized children through supporting their education decided to provide high quality education to under privileged children. Hence HEARD Nepal has joined hand with the Uplift A Child International, a Non profitable organization that helps poor and needy children to complete their quality education in many countries around the world. Children in rural Nepal do not have access to quality education as the quality of education imparted to these children is poor. Most of the poor students drop their schools due to financial crises. This Sponsorship program aimed to ensure the quality education to the selected children and help the children realize their full potential. The project seeks to ensure quality education for children in rural areas and to create equal opportunities.

Procedure

HEARD Nepal's founder, president and professional volunteers and coordinator accessed Udaypur District of Eastern Nepal located in the joining area of Hill and Terai region to find out the basically required School with quality English Medium Education. Shree Janata Namuna Secondary School was found fulfilling all the criterias which was provided by Uplift a child international. It was a government English medium school recognized by Nepal Government for its excellent performance too. The Volunteer Team then arranged meeting along with HEARD Nepal Officials with the school principal, management committee, teachers and local reputed personnels too. Afterwards, the joint team was made along with them for finding out the most

poor and vulnerable students from around the locality who could complete up to secondary level education regularly if supported. 31 students were finalized for the sponsorship program.

Distribution Day Event

Organized by HEARD Nepal with the financial support of Uplift a child International, a ceremony was held at Namuna Janata School of Hadiya, Udayapur on 19 October 2022. All the children of the school, all the teachers, staff, all the students who have been awarded scholarships and their parents were cordially invited to participate in the program. The program started at 11 am. Deputy mayor, chief administrative officer, head of education department of municipality, technical advisor of HEARD Nepal, board members, professional volunteers of HEARD Nepal, local social workers, school management committee program and many others participated in this program.

Registration, National Anthem, and Welcome speech

School children, Teachers, Stakeholders and EDPs attended the National Anthem after the registration. Welcome Speech was given by School Teacher.
